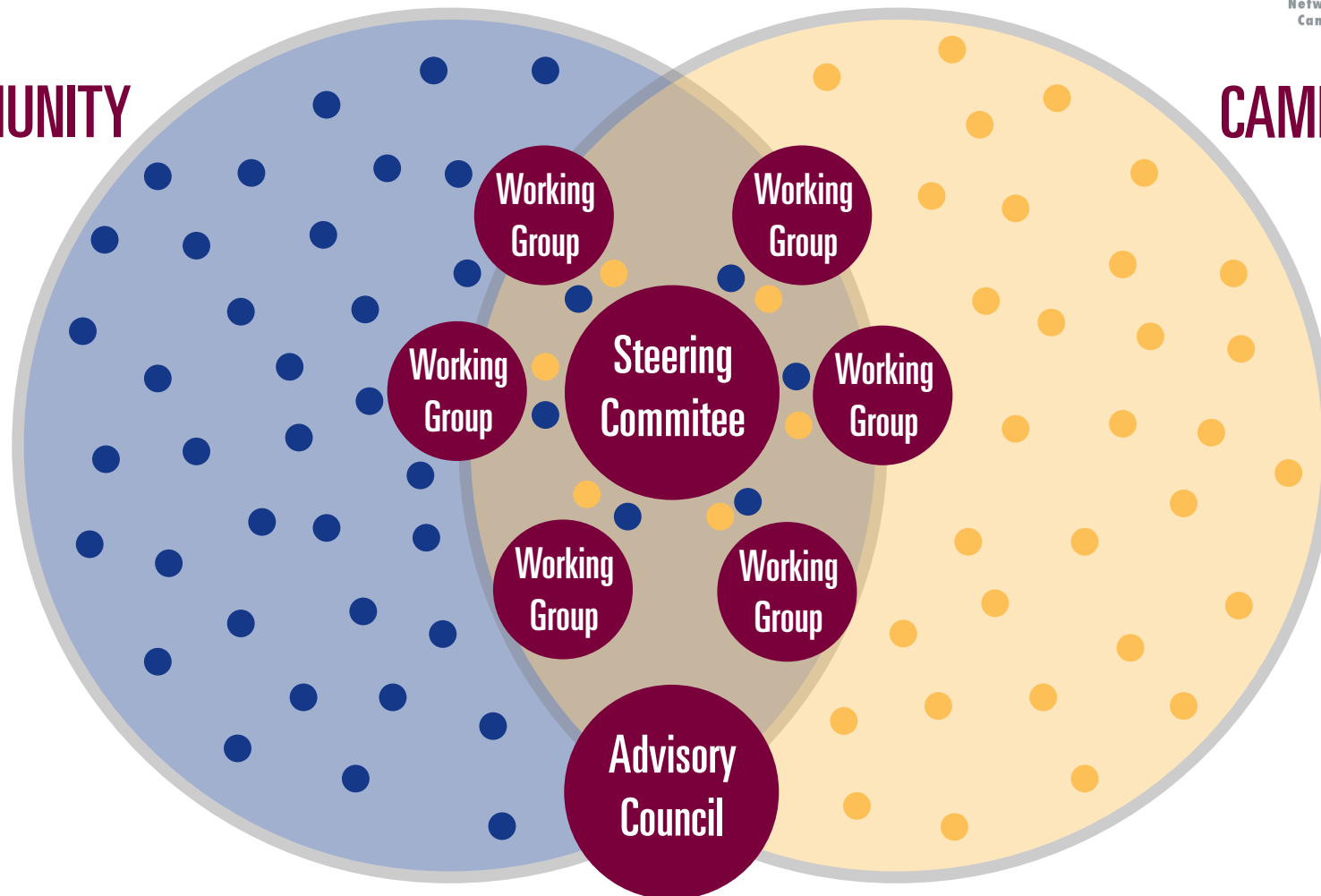

Advisory Council

Composition: 15 advisors representing the University, the greater Hamilton community, and regional, national, or global perspectives on community engagement.

Role: Provide advice, feedback, and direction to the Network.

Steering Committee

Composition: Faculty, staff, and students from the Office of Community Engagement and co-chairs of Network Working Groups.

Role: Coordination, Information sharing, and alignment across working groups. Decision-making body regarding working group actions and funding from catalyst grants.

Working Groups

Composition: 8-12 members co-chaired by community and campus representatives.

Role: Pursue actions that address pillars of community engagement to help achieve strategic plan objectives and support community-driven priorities.

Network Liaisons

Composition: Representatives from any community or University unit, group, or organization that wishes to engage with the Network.

Role: Point of contact with the Network to support pillars of community engagement, contributing to Network activities and serving on working groups where appropriate.
